VISION & PHILOSOPHY:

To provide leadership in the creation of a complete hockey experience designed to cultivate each player's passion for the sport. Establish a culture of esprit de corps in a safe, clean and ethical atmosphere that empowers athletes. Develop the physical, cognitive, emotional and social dimensions of every player.

SELECTION & TEAM DECLARATION PROCESS: For Mites through Bantams

Note: Midgets are placed on teams at the initial tryouts

In order to ensure athletes are placed on the appropriate team, and that the team is placed at the appropriate competitive level, we use a multi-phase selection and declaration process. **It is our intention to field AA, A & B at each level based on the talent pool without compromising the integrity of the competitive component in the development process.**

Phase I Spring Tryouts: (May) For a variety of reasons, tryout week often provides a false impression of an athlete's ability. We evaluate candidates based on their body of work whenever possible. During the season three evaluations are conducted. The results of those evaluations are taken into account during the tryout phase. Depending on the quality and quantity of the player pool, the coaching staff for each level will determine and fill the required number of roster spots. Once selected, each player will be required to secure their spot with a deposit on the final night of tryouts. This will insure that you have a place to play next year.

Phase II Spring Training Sessions: (May-June) Over the next two months as players continue to grow and mature at varying rates they will participate in training sessions. At these practices we will continue to challenge and evaluate each candidate and begin to assess the collective ability of the group.

Phase III Final & Declaration: (June) Conducted following spring clinics and just prior to the NJYHL team declaration deadline. Candidates will be sorted out and assigned to a team that best suits their ability. Coaches will be assigned a team and teams will be placed at the appropriate competitive levels (AA, A or B).

JIM HUNT-Former NCAA Division I head coach and assistant coach of 2008 U.S. World Jr. Team and the 2006 U18 World Championship US National Team. Recipient of the 2003 New Jersey Devils – Dr. John J. McMullen Service Award. Coach Hunt serves as the USA Hockey Atlantic District Vice President of Player Development and has over 20 years experience in the training and development of hockey players.
